

Out and About in UpDoNA: Botero Sculptures

Denver's Public Art Program was established in 1988 as an Executive Order under Mayor Federico Peña. The order, enacted into Ordinance by Denver City Council in 1991, directs that 1% of any capital improvement project over \$1 million undertaken by the City, be set aside for the inclusion of art. Over the past two decades, Denver has installed more than 150 works of art under this program. A large amount of
