Denver City Council Unanimously Approves New Scooter Legislation: Downtown Denver's City Councilman Chris Hinds managed to accumulate 100% support for his new scooter legislation. The new rules are intended to (1) reduce the scooter litter on our sidewalks (by requiring users to park in designated marked-off areas, a.k.a. scooter corrals), and (2) reduce or eliminate the use of scooters on our downtown sidewalks.
