# President's Message: Lisa Pope

<u>Downtown Denver National Night Out –</u> Tuesday, August 5<sup>th</sup>, 4:30-7:30 p.m., at Skyline Park 1 located on Arapahoe Street between 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> Streets. Don't forget to attend this year's Downtown Denver National Night Out! Michael Spencer from CBS Colorado is this year's emcee. Our guests include Mayor Johnston, DPD Deputy Chief Sanchez, DFD Chief Fulton, newly appointed RTD Chief Martingano, Council Members Hinds and Watson, and many others.

**State of the City Address**: Gil Vondrasek, Jen Kellison, and I attended Mayor Johnston's State of the City address on Monday, July 21<sup>st</sup> at the Seawell Ballroom. Several hundred people were in attendance. During his address, Mayor Johnston spoke about Colorado's history, where we've been and where we are going. He emphasized some of the accomplishments in his first two years: reducing unsheltered homelessness by 45%, including getting 7,000 people off the streets, providing 1,000 units of transitional housing, and getting 5,000 people into permanent housing, hiring 300 new Denver police officers, a 46% decrease in homicides, largest reduction of any top 50 U.S. city, the new Denver Permitting office, etc.

### **New Legislation Cracks Down On Derelict Buildings**

On July 14, Denver's City Council unanimously amended Chapter 10 of the municipal code to confront roughly 300 derelict and neglected properties with far tougher penalties. Owners now face fines up to \$5,000 per day for each day of non-compliance—up from the previous \$999 maximum—marking the first major update to this ordinance since 2012.

Under the new rules, a derelict building is any unoccupied structure that inspectors deem unsafe, a chronic code violator or public nuisance, or that is more than a year behind on property taxes. The definition also embraces vacant lots.

### Partnering For A Safer Upper Downtown

At UpDoNA, our safety strategy centers on ongoing dialogue with Denver Police leadership. Each month, we participate in the District 6 Citizen's Advisory Group (CAG) to stay informed, share neighborhood concerns, and strengthen our partnership with law enforcement. In addition, we have monthly conversations with Lieutenant Albi regarding statistics and specific incidents; Ryan Ertman, head of security for the Downtown Denver Partnership; and Armando Saldate, head of Denver's Department of Safety, reporting to Mayor Johnston. Lisa Pope also serves on Denver's Police Advisory Board and meets with Police leadership.

### **Mapping Upper Downtown Art Works**

To take us to the next step in planning and implementing artworks and beautification projects in Upper Downtown, the Arts & Beautification Committee is inventorying Upper Downtown arts and flora. We have divided Upper Downtown into 22 blocks. Our first focus is on the arts. In our Arts Inventory, for each block, our committee volunteers are recording all of the present artwork that is publicly available. For each piece we provide a brief description of the piece, the materials used for the piece, approximately where it is located on the block, the artist (if it is determinable) and any other relevant information we think would be helpful. We also note the condition of the piece and if it is in disrepair. So far, we have completed eight blocks.
